In this six-session DVD study with participant's guide, you will not only learn about the person of the Holy Spirit, you will learn: How to make room for the Spirit's action in your life and in your church; how God wants to work through your gifts and talents to enable you to do what only he can do; how to listen for the voice of the Spirit in prayer and how to apply God's Word to your life; how the Spirit can bring healing to your body, your emotions, and your relationships; how a life lived in the presence of the Spirit can transform the church and the world; and how your church can become a place where people regularly experience God's presence and his power. Pastor and bestselling author Jim Cymbala shows you how to welcome God's Spirit in a way that can invigorate your church and infuse a fresh sense of his power in your life.</p> <p>The Book of Amos: The central idea of the book of Amos is that God puts his people on the same level as the surrounding nations - God expects the same purity of them all. As it is with all nations that rise up against the kingdom of God, even Israel and Judah will not be exempt from the judgment of God because of their idolatry and unjust ways. The nation that represents YHVH must be made pure of anything or anyone that profanes the name of God. God's name must be exalted.</p> <p>Other major ideas in the book of Amos include: social justice and concern for the disadvantaged; the idea that Israel's covenant with God did not exempt them from accountability for sin; God is God of all nations; God is judge of all nations; God is God of moral righteousness; God made all people; God elected Israel and then liberated Israel so that He would be known throughout the world; election by God means that those elected are responsible to live according to the purposes clearly outlined to them in the covenant; if God destroys the unjust, a remnant will remain; and God is free to judge whether to redeem Israel.</p>	<p>Reynolds building Room #3</p>

Little presents his message in a way that can be shared with Christians and non-Christians alike. In an age where truth is a victim, Little states that there is only one way to God, and that is through Jesus Christ.</p> <p>Is there a God? Is Christian rational? Do Science and Scripture agree? Does Christianity really differ from other world religions? These are not only the questions of your heart but also some of the chapter titles of this book. If you have found yourself asking similar questions about Christianity, you need to know that Christian faith and reason are compatible and Paul E.
