<p>Living like you belong to God (6 weeks) Rising to the call of leadership(6 weeks) (10th – 12th grade class)</p> <p>Teachers: Herald Lebiga</p>	<p>Living Like You Belong To God Can others see that you belong to God? God calls us to a life of joy, obedience, and trust. He calls us to be different from those around us. He calls us to be holy. Discover that holiness is not an arbitrary standard within today's church or an unreachable goal of sinless perfection. Holiness is about pleasing God — living in such a way that it's clear you belong to Him. Holiness is what makes you unique as a believer in Jesus Christ. Come explore the beauty of holy living and see why true holiness and true happiness always go together.</p> <p>Rising to the call of leadership(6 weeks) God calls every one of His people to positions of leadership and influence—in our homes, communities, churches, and ultimately the world. But true leadership involves more than simply being the person out front; it means living a life worth following. In this study of four important leaders of Israel—Eli, Samuel, Saul, and David—you'll explore key leadership principles, including how to make wise decisions under pressure, deal effectively with mistakes, and set a course that others will follow. <p>Feeling and Emotion & Peer Pressure</p> <p><i>(7th – 9th grade class)</i></p> <p>Teacher: Hazel Lebiga Calvin Yang</p>	<p>Feeling and Emotion This study teaches students that true contentment comes only through a relationship with Jesus--and that God's love is everlasting, unlike worldly love which fades. Students also learn that God's total acceptance of us is the model for how they should accept others. This book stresses that violence against ourselves or others only hurts all concerned.</p> <p>Peer Pressure Every day junior highers must decide whether to stand up to or give into peer pressure. Here they see the advantages of rising above peer pressure as well as the painful price paid by those with "weak knees." Those who stood up for Godly principles include Joseph, Hosea and Daniel, while the weak-kneed discussed are Rehoboam, Ananias and Saphira, and Samson and Delilah.
